 - Begin to fill out the TRA Community Service Packet (required for graduation)
- Begin to explore college and career opportunities.
 - Speak with people who do jobs you would be interested.
 - It is not too early to visit college campuses or trade schools.
- Work on your Extra-Curriculars—These will be represented on your transcript!
 - Schools and scholarships like to see what else you do other than course work
 - Consider organizations such as 4-H or other civic clubs, orchestra, theater, yearbook etc.
 - Consider leadership opportunities such as Student Council, Youth Group Leadership
