

## The Rock Academy Dual Enrollment

Currently, TRA is only contracted for dual enrollment with Seminole State College. SSC requires that high school students attend a Seminole County high school, so TRA students are eligible for dual enrollment there regardless of where they live.

1. **TRA must recommend** and approve each student for dual enrollment.
  - Consideration is given for work ethic, attendance, grades, and maturity.
2. **Currently, Dual Enrollment** is being offered to qualified juniors and seniors only (11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grades).
3. **Students and Parents** may obtain the necessary signed documents to begin the process from the TRA office.
4. **Application Process:**
  - Take these documents to the SSC Administration Office.
  - Within 24 hours, your student will be given an SSC Student ID (emailed).
  - With this ID, you will schedule the PERT exam (unless you already have qualifying ACT or SAT scores)
  - The PERT exam is given untimed and will tell you immediately if you are eligible for dual enrollment.
  - You must pass BOTH math and English portions of the Pert to be eligible.
5. **Choosing Classes (Limit 3 per semester)**
  - TRA will provide you with the next documents necessary to choose your classes.
  - This document must be signed by TRA Admin or Guidance
  - Classes must be on your TRA Graduation plan or fill a graduation requirement.
  - You may go online to the SSC Course Catalog to choose your classes.

  - You will choose course title, location, time, and/or live or online.
  - You take this form to the college to complete the enrollment.
