Standardized Testing

- When you register for the SAT or ACT you must use our **CODE 102-330**
- You **MUST** have your scores sent to one of the 12 Florida Public Universities to ensure that your scores are put on record for scholarships. This is done at REGISTRATION

Attendance

1. If you are on a state scholarship that requires on campus hours, TRA provides your attendance
2. If you are **NOT** on a state scholarship and are **NOT** on campus full time, you **MUST** use the TRA Attendance Forms and turn them in each QUARTER

Community Service. (College Prep: 100 hours; Standard: 75 hours)

1. Check to see that your service area is approved by TRA
2. Document the Hours (only 1/3 of church service can count toward the total)
3. Fill out the TRA PACKET
4. Write the 300-word Essay
5. Turn it in for graduation

Bright Futures

1. You **MUST** Apply before TRA can begin the process
2. You **MUST** take the appropriate College Prep Courses and get good grades
3. You **MUST** meet the minimum test scores
4. You **MUST** complete the Community Service Hours.
5. You **MUST** have your test scores sent to one of the 12 universities in the state of Florida for Bright Futures to have access to them.
