### Class Selection Guidelines

1. All course selections must be approved by TRA Administration
2. These guidelines apply to all enrolled students whether they take their courses on or off-campus.

### Middle School. (5<sup>th</sup> -8<sup>th</sup> grades). The following courses should be selected annually through Middle School:

- Language Arts (must include grammar)
- Math
- Science
- Social Studies
- Elective (An elective is optional but highly recommended.)
