Goals

The first semester, students will learn all about the techniques of singing in a group. They will work on unison, parts, blending and performance. There will be no homework for this elective course.

The second semester, students will dive into the wonderful world of creating, preparing and performing a play. We will work week by week to memorize scripts, sing, and dance. They will learn to work together as a team through dialogue format as well as perform as individuals through monologue format. Students will learn each role in the theater and take an active part in utilizing them. They will have to audition for the play, but each student will receive a part. *****This semester takes a lot of hard work and TIME! Please be prepared as the rehearsal schedule will be handed out in January and you WILL be required to sign it saying your child will attend all rehearsals.***
