**1 General 3-ring Binder (2 inch)** with 5-tab dividers for English, History and Science

**1 Math 3-ring Binder (1.5 inch)** with tab dividers

English, History, and Science **can all go in the ONE BINDER this year.**

- **Physical Science**
  - calculator
- **Language Arts I:**
  - highlighters: (pink, yellow, green, blue, and orange)
  - white and colored index cards
  - small pencil sharpener
  - pocket dictionary
- **Language Arts II:**
  - composition notebook
  - highlighters: (pink, yellow, green, blue, and orange)
  - pocket dictionary
- **Math**
  - straight edge (protractor or ruler)
  - graph paper

## Supplies For Students taking ART

### Drawing Supplies:

- **Sketchbook:** A sketchbook (preferably 9"x12") is a great place for students to practice their drawing skills.
- **Graphite Pencils:** A range of graphite pencils (HB, 2B, 4B, 6B) is essential for various drawing techniques.
- **Erasers:** Kneaded and vinyl erasers are helpful for correcting mistakes and creating different effects.
- **Sharpener:** A pencil sharpener ensures pencils are ready for use.
- **Charcoal:** Charcoal sticks (compressed and vine) offer a different medium for sketching and shading.
- **Colored Pencils:** Colored pencils provide a way to add color and detail to drawings.

### Other Materials:

- **Markers:** Markers (fine tip and broad tip) are useful for adding details and creating vibrant colors.
- **Ruler:** A ruler is helpful for measuring and drawing straight lines.
- **Scissors:** Scissors are essential for cutting paper and other materials.
- **Glue:** Glue (liquid and stick) is needed for assembling artwork and other projects.
- **Tape:** Masking tape and painter's tape can be used for creating borders and masking sections of a painting.
- **Apron or Old Shirt:** An apron or old shirt helps protect clothing from paint and other art materials.
- **Storage Container:** A storage container helps keep supplies organized and easy to access.
